## Senate and House TSCA Reform Bills: What Do They Say? Where Are They Going?

**Webinar Description:** This webinar will discuss two long-awaited bills to reform the Toxic Substances Control Act. Senator Frank Lautenberg (D-NJ) and Representatives Bobby Rush (D-IL) and Henry Waxman (D-CA) unveiled the Safe Chemical Act of 2010 earlier this spring. Despite earlier attempt to overhaul the way the country manages chemicals, this is the first time that both chemical industry lobbyists and public health advocates agree that we can't delay change any longer — the scientific evidence is too overwhelming; the public outcry too loud. The Safer Chemicals, Healthy Families coalition (of which Ms. Dahl is Deputy Campaign Director) supports the goals of the bill. As always, "the devil is in the details." Join the webinar to learn what the bills say, what the controversial issues are and what the prognosis for the future of toxic chemical policy reform is.
