

# Overview of 2020 Activities

- Presented 32 cutting-edge educational webinars attended by over 11,000 learners.
- Co-sponsored and facilitated the Reinventing Quality virtual conference attended by 1,550 learners
- Provided a library of online courses that enrolled over 1,000 learners
- Published 106 articles in AAIDD's 3 peer-reviewed journals
- Improved knowledge transfer with the release of pre-press articles
- Completed production of Intellectual Disability: Definition, Diagnosis, Classification, and Systems of Supports, 12th Edition, published in January, 2021
- Guided 2 additional book manuscripts toward their anticipated publication in 2021
- Pivoted training to support virtual training and remote assessment
- Trained more than 450 professionals in the use of SIS-A and SIS-C in 15 U.S.
   States and Canadian Provinces
- Assisted state enterprises by performing over 175 SIS assessments and housing over 37,000 SIS new assessments records
- Supported research demonstrating the reliability and validity of remote SIS assessments and research concerning re-norming the adult version
