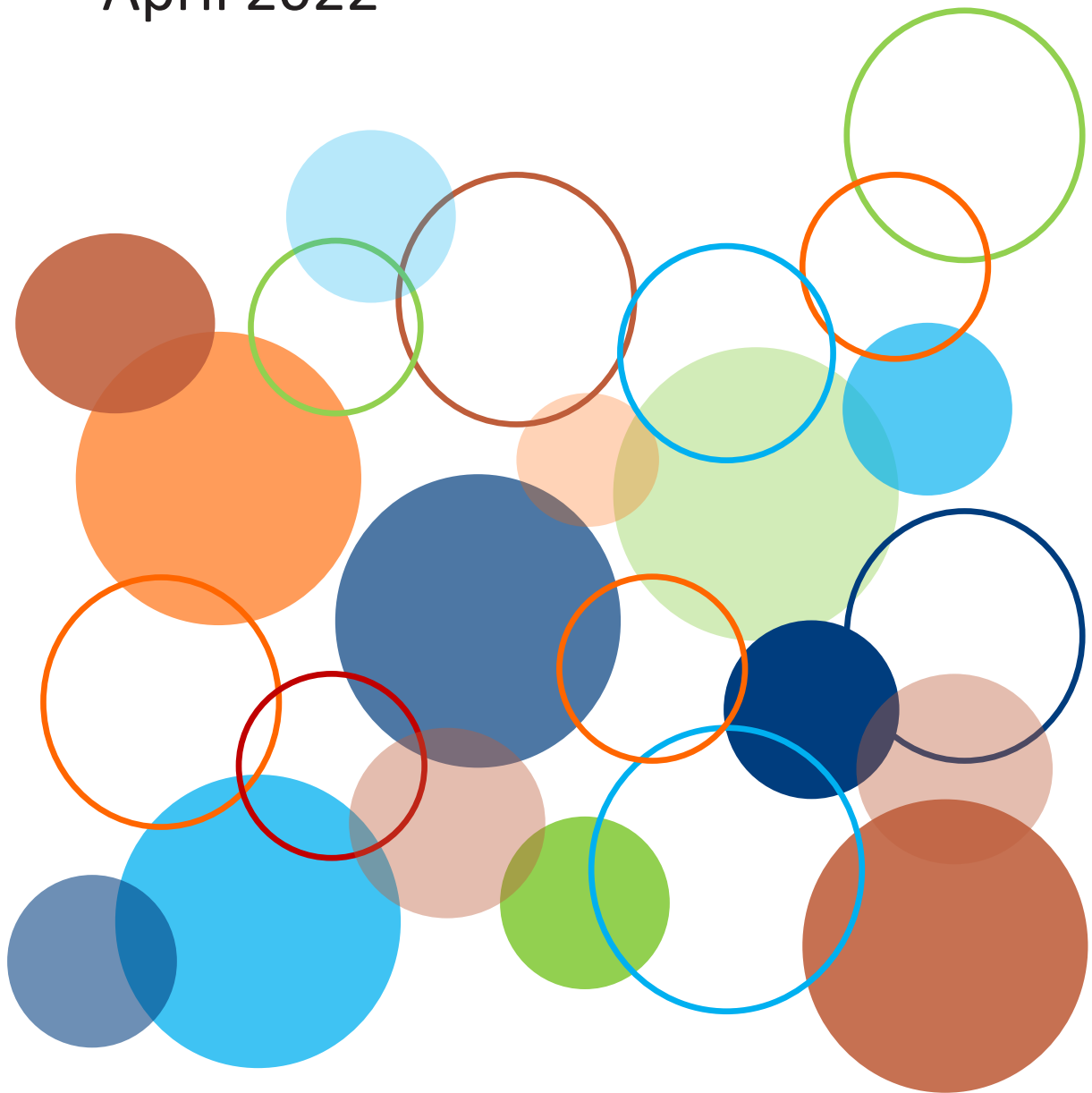

Overview of 2021 Activities

Education

- Presented **32** cutting-edge educational webinars attended by over **10,000** learners
- Hosted virtual annual meeting attended by **500** leaders in the field
- Co-sponsored and facilitated the Reinventing Quality virtual conference
- Introduced **2** new online courses to our Academy, AAIDD's online courses enrolled over **1,000** learners
- Contributed to knowledge transfer through the production of journal article highlights on social media

Publications

- Published **105** articles in AAIDD's **3** peer-reviewed journals
- Improved knowledge transfer with the release of pre-press articles each month
- Published *Intellectual Disability: Definition, Diagnosis, Classification, and Systems of Supports, 12th Edition* in English, Canadian French, and Spanish as it is spoken in the United States
- Guided **2** additional book manuscripts toward their anticipated publication in 2022

Supports Intensity Scale

- Provided training to support virtual training and assessment
- Trained almost **350** professionals in the use of SIS-A and SIS-C in **25** jurisdictions in the U.S., Canada, and Brazil
- Developed new resource videos in English, Spanish, and French
- Assisted state enterprises by performing over **630** SIS assessments and housing over **36,150** new SIS assessments records
- Contributed to the evidenced-based literature on developing competencies in virtual training

Governance

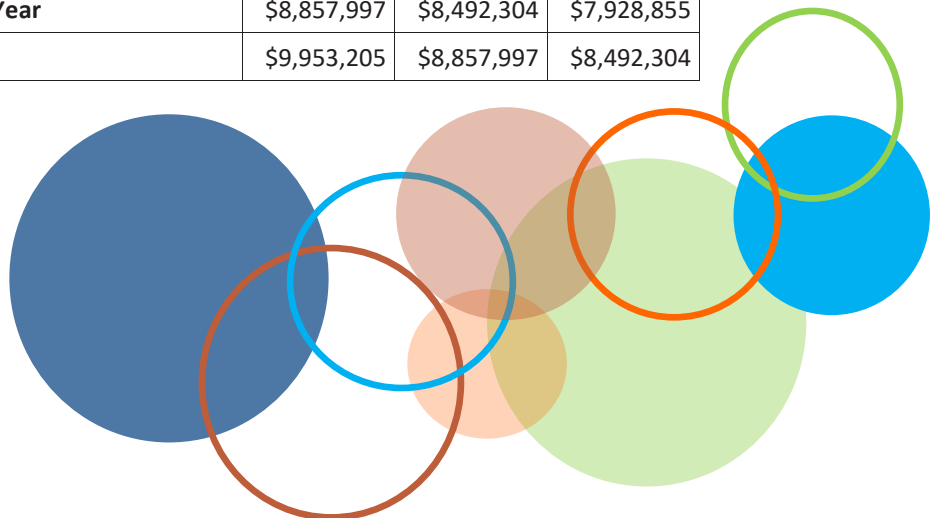
- Stewarded and championed the Association

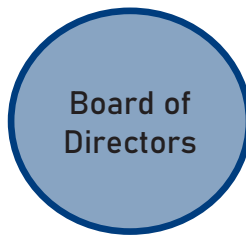
