The board held meetings in August 2024, October 2024, January 2025, April 2025, and June 2025. Meetings in October 2024 and April 2025 were open to all interested network members and served as both networking opportunities and business meetings. The June 2025 meeting was held in person at the AAIDD Annual Conference.

In Fall 2024, the leadership created and distributed a survey to assess membership needs, interests, and guide future network activities.

The Interest Network created a LinkedIn page to provide updates on meetings, events, and other relevant announcements. They also sent out periodic emails to the membership to advertise upcoming events.

The board made a call for proposals to organize a panel for the 2025 annual conference, but did not receive any interest this year. Interest Network funds were used to award one Merit Award to a SECP gerontology-related conference presentation and one gift card prize for the SECP reception. We also continued with our "Aging Rocks" pins to advertise the interest network at the Annual Conference.
