### Education

### Membership & Communications

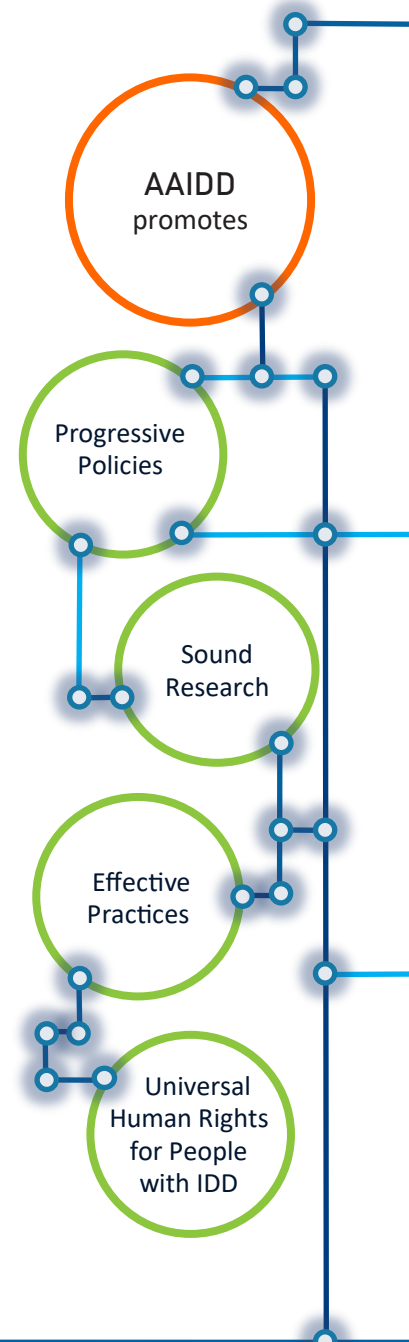
- Recruited new members and retained existing members

- Preferred **11** new Fellows of the Association

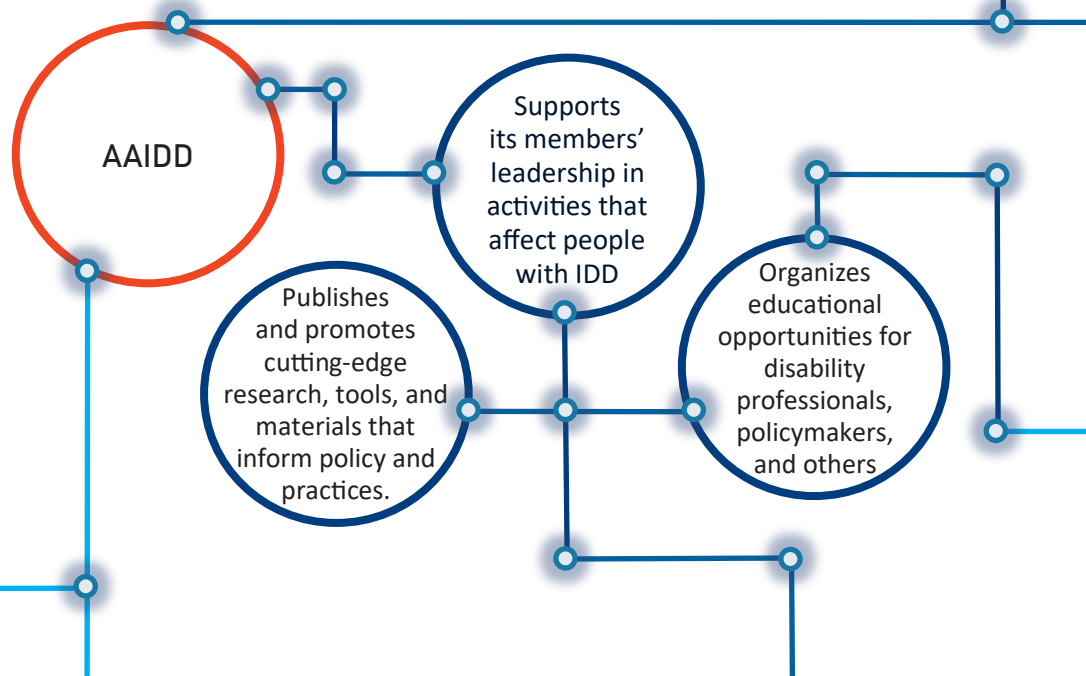
