<p>Objective 1 – Collaborate with other interest networks.</p> <p><u>Planned activity 1:</u> Collaborate with SECP (Students and Early Career Professionals) interest network on the 6th annual Research Colloquium (offered pre-conference).</p> <p><u>Planned activity 2:</u> We will collaborate with SECP leadership to identify at least two additional ways that the RIN can support SECP members (e.g., support proposal development, clarify the review and feedback process for the pre-conference, researcher Q&A).</p>	<p><u>Planned activity 1:</u> The RIN co-hosted the in-person pre-conference SECP Research Colloquium to support students and early career professionals on Monday June 13, 3:30-5:00. Six SECP members presented their work and all RIN leadership members provided feedback on submissions before the pre-conference. At the pre-conference, approximately 25 attendees also provided feedback on SECP presentations.</p> <p><u>Planned activity 2:</u> We collaborated with the SECP IN to revise the SECP Research Colloquium abstract submission to: 1) Align with current AAIDD abstract guidelines, 2) Provide opportunities for completed research as well as research in progress, and 3) Provide submitting SECP members with the opportunity to identify specific areas in which feedback is desired/needed.</p> <p>Funds used: \$0</p>
<p>Objective 2 – Support students.</p> <p>Provide student scholarships for the annual conference. We will partner with SECP and AAIDD to refine the process of identifying the targeted audience for these scholarships/awards.</p>	<p>Members of the RIN executive committee and RIN members peer-reviewed 40 research proposals first authored by SECPs. RIN membership fees allowed us to generously provide travel awards to three outstanding SECPs. The RIN executive committee began discussing a process to explore best practices in the creation of plain language summaries and abstracts, and developed a plan to systematically gather information from other journals and organizations in 2022-2023.</p> <p>Funds used: \$0</p>
<p>Objective 5 – Improve communication.</p> <p>Regular communication within the Research Interest Network using the regularly updated membership list. We will explore other formats to enhance networking and sharing between RIN membership (e.g., coffee hour chats, research in progress forums).</p>	<p>We invited members of the RIN to assist in the review of SECP abstracts for the AAIDD travel awards. X RIN members reviewed proposal submissions.</p> <p>We encouraged RIN members to register and attend the free SECP Research Colloquium pre-conference session.</p> <p>Members of the executive committee (including members at large) attended AAIDD Assembly of Interest Network Meetings and SECP meetings.</p> <p>We held our Annual Business Meeting on June 8th. Sixteen members attended.
